This year, the hospital has nominated one of their volunteers, Mrs Libby Howe for the WA Volunteer of the Year Award, with winners announced at the National Volunteer Week Gala Dinner and Awards Presentation at the Hyatt Regency Perth Hotel on Wednesday 15 May 2013.

Bethesda Hospital Volunteer Manager, Ms Sahara Scaddan noted that 'Libby was one of the first volunteers in the Palliative Care Unit when it opened in 2006. Since then, she has generously given her time on a weekly basis to provide companionship, comfort and support to terminally ill patients and their families'.

'Libby also assists with fundraising efforts and tends to the hospital garden which is a relaxation spot for palliative care patients. Libby's genuine warmth, compassion and generosity is greatly appreciated by patients, visitors and staff alike, and she was a popular choice to be nominated for WA Volunteer of the Year'.

Libby was a previously a nurse, and has been volunteering for 12 years. She initially worked at the Cottage Hospice and moved across to Bethesda Hospital when this closed down.

Libby said that 'volunteering is a fantastic opportunity for me to give something back to the community, and make a difference to people's lives. I am also able to enjoy my other passion of gardening whilst working at the hospital'.
